

*Terms and conditions apply:*

- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times during the Easter Egg hunt (the “**Hunt**”). Adults are wholly responsible for the care and supervision of the children at all times during the Hunt. The Hunt will take place between the hours of 10-1700 on Sunday 27 March 2016 (and subject to availability).
- Adults accompanying children during the Hunt are responsible for ensuring that children do not ingest the eggs found during the Hunt. Supervising adults must note and advise participating children that the eggs are not edible.
- The eggs are not suitable for children under the age of 3 (three). The Hunt is only open to participants under the age of 16 (sixteen).
- Eggs found during the Hunt may be exchanged for an item of confectionary in the Lily O’Brien’s boutique in Kildare Village. There is a limit of 1 (one) egg per child and children may not redeem more than (one) egg for an item of confectionary. Exchange of confectionary is subject to availability at the Lily O’Brien’s boutique in Kildare Village. The eggs have no cash value and may not be exchanged for the cash equivalent of an item of confectionary in the Lily O’Briens boutique in Kildare Village.
- Kildare Village is the sponsor of the Hunt. The owner of Kildare Village bears no responsibility whatsoever for participants taking part in the Hunt and participants take place in the Hunt entirely at their own risk. Participants in the Hunt hereby waive and release the owner of Kildare Village, its related companies, servants, agents, officers and employees and the Lily O’Briens boutique in Kildare Village from all actions, proceedings, costs, claims, losses and demands howsoever arising due to their participation in the Hunt.
- By taking part in the Hunt, supervising adults hereby accept that they, and participating children, are bound unconditionally to these Terms And Conditions.
