Term's and Conditions:

To qualify for the free gift participants must:

How to use the patches:

- The patches are stickers for textiles and accessories with smooth surfaces. Its glue is meant to stick and stay in place. If the patches are moved or removed (accidentally or deliberately) it may leave a residue on, or cause damage to, the surfaces you attach them to. The patches may not stick to rough surfaces.
- Do not permanently expose the patches to excessive heat, sunlight or extreme cold. If the patches are not being used, store them in their packaging in a cool dark place.
- When you decide to use the patches: first, choose your position on the garment or product you want to personalise, and then peel off the patch's backing and stick it in place. Once there patches should not be repositioned as their glue may stop working and it could damage the garment or product if moved. If you wash the patches or put them in the tumble dryer they may become unstuck, get damaged or their colours may run and may damage other items in the wash. If you want to make the patches permanent you can sew them into place.
- Do not give the patches to anyone under the age of three or anyone who might want to chew them. Do not stick the patches to anything without parental supervision and permission.
